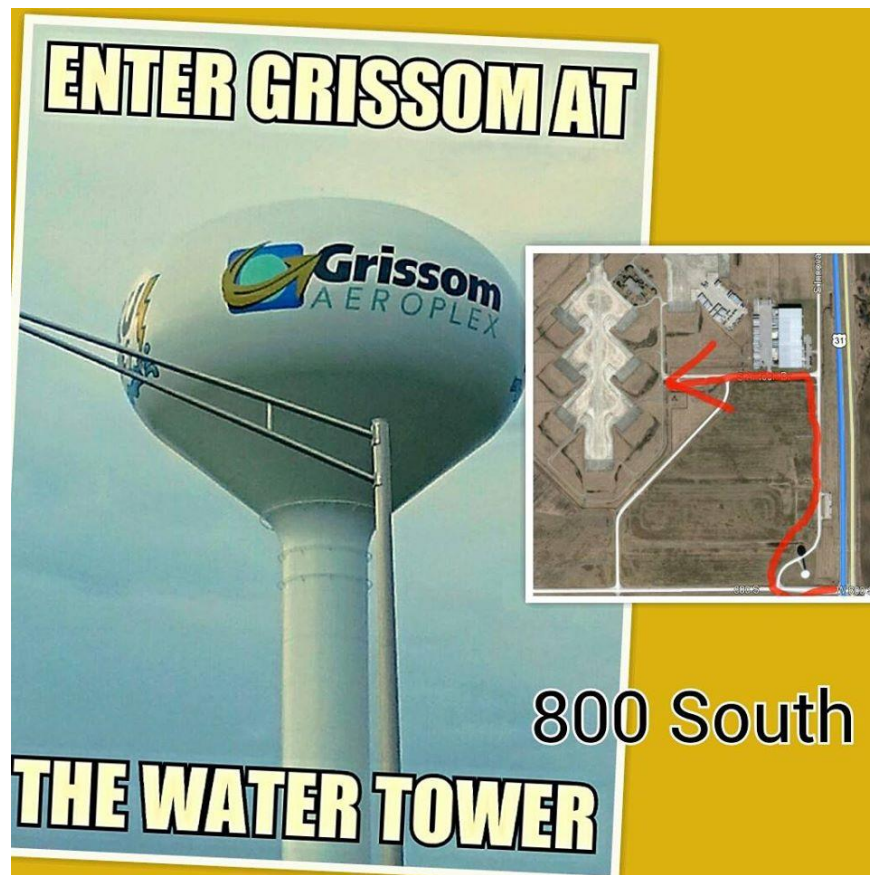
Registration fees: ***YOU MUST PRE-REGISTER TO GET THE 2-DAY DISCOUNT***
