9:30am - 10:50 Registration Open

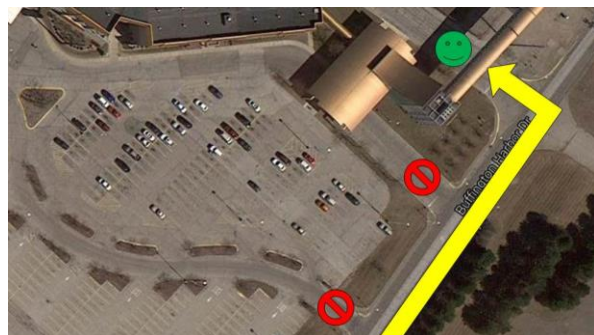
9:30am - 11:00 Tech Inspection
